

Steve Wozniak

- Cofounder of apple
- 1976-1985: Vice president of research and development at Apple
- Designer of the Apple computers
- Born August 11, 1950
- Always interested in electronics and mathematics
- In sixth grade had a HAM radio license
- Worked at Hewlett Packard for 3 years designing calculator chips
- 1976: Created Apple I with Jobs
- 1985: Got bachelors degree in computer science and electrical engineering


