    - 1. Absolutely no foreign investment
    - 2. Focus on heavy machinery
    - 3. 1928 1938 = coal production increased 4x
    - 4. By 1938 USSR = largest producer of tractors and locomotives; second only to US in gross industrial production
  - C. Third 5 Year Plan interrupted by WWII
  - D. Fourth 5 Year Plan (1946 1950) = War recovery
- III. Impact of Stalinization (Good and Bad)

    - 1. Party control Gosplan
    - 2. Limited Input/Purges
    - 3. Heavy use of Propaganda
